## Visit Old Havana

After breakfast we will take a guided tour the cigar factory **Partagas**; then a Walking tour of Habana Vieja. Explore the historical and oldest district of Havana; walk along Plaza Vieja, Mercaderes Street, Plaza de Armas and the Cathedral. Afternoon is free to explore Old Havana and have lunch on your own. At 8:00 pm we will meet for farewell dinner at the famous paladar **El Cocinero**, one of Havana’s newest and most avant-garde restaurants; and conclude the night next door at **Fabrica del Arte (The Art Factory)**, an avant-garde art venue that is the home to everything art: theater, jazz, contemporary dance, exhibitions, etc. (Meals: B,D)

DAY 5

## Departure

After breakfast and checkout we will visit el Mercado de Artesania (artisan market), in Old Havana. At noon we will continue to visit to the colorful **Callejon de Hamel**, one of the shortest but most interesting streets in Havana. See Funky street murals, psychedelic art shops and frenetic rumba music, and discover how the African Cuban religion of Santeria, a fusion of African belief systems like spirit worship and Christianity, is portrayed in street art and music. We will stop for lunch on the way to the airport for a 6:00pm departure arriving in Miami by 7:00 pm (Meals: B)

## ACTIVITIES

- 4 A visit to the facilities of a private Cooperative, where their workers, own and run the enterprise. One of the workers/ owners will tell the group of their experiences and how cooperatives are working in Cuba; and the advantages and disadvantages for foreign partners/investors.
- 5 Visit the Trade Center new Wi-Fi zone, a shopping center and a modern supermarket.
- 6 Visit the community project and exchange information and knowledge with organizers and participants of the project
- 7 Talk with an attorney real estate expert about the Cuban real estate market: past, present and future.

## LODGING
